Does Kenya have solar energy?

Solar energy Kenya boasts abundant sunlight throughout the year, presenting significant potential for harnessing solar energy. Its geographical location results in high insolation, with average peak sunshine hours ranging between 5 and 7 and an average daily insolation of 4-6 kWh/m² [88, 89].

How is electricity generated in Kenya?

Electricity generation in Kenya has been predominantly driven by renewable energy, contributing 80 % of the total supply, with an estimated annual growth of 3.1 % . Kenya has relatively low per capita electricity consumption, estimated at approximately 190 kWh per year, compared to global average of roughly 3,200 kWh .

How much electricity does Kenya use per capita?

Kenya's per capita electricity consumption stands at 252 kWh, which is significantly below the global average of 3649 kWh per person. This relatively low level of electricity generation can limit economic development and hinder technological advances, impacting the overall quality of life and accessibility to modern facilities for residents.

What is the irradiance of solar power in Kenya?

In Kenya, the direct normal irradiance (DNI) ranges between 1454 and 6649 Wh/m², with the western region having the lowest, while the northeastern region has a higher potential for concentrated solar power (CSP) [93,94]. The classification of the DNI in Kenya was studied by Ref. using SWERA within a range of 1-10 suitability.

How can Kenya increase its electricity generation capacity by 5000 MW?

Aims to increase Kenya's electricity generation capacity by over 5000 MW within 40 months. Focuses on developing a mix of energy sources including geothermal, wind, coal, and natural gas. How much electricity will Kenya have in 2021?

The total interconnected electricity capacity in Kenya is projected to experience significant growth from the current 2708 MW in 2021 to 4763 MW in 2037 in the low scenario, 2103 MW-6638 MW in the reference scenario, and 2293 MW-9790 MW in the vision scenario.
